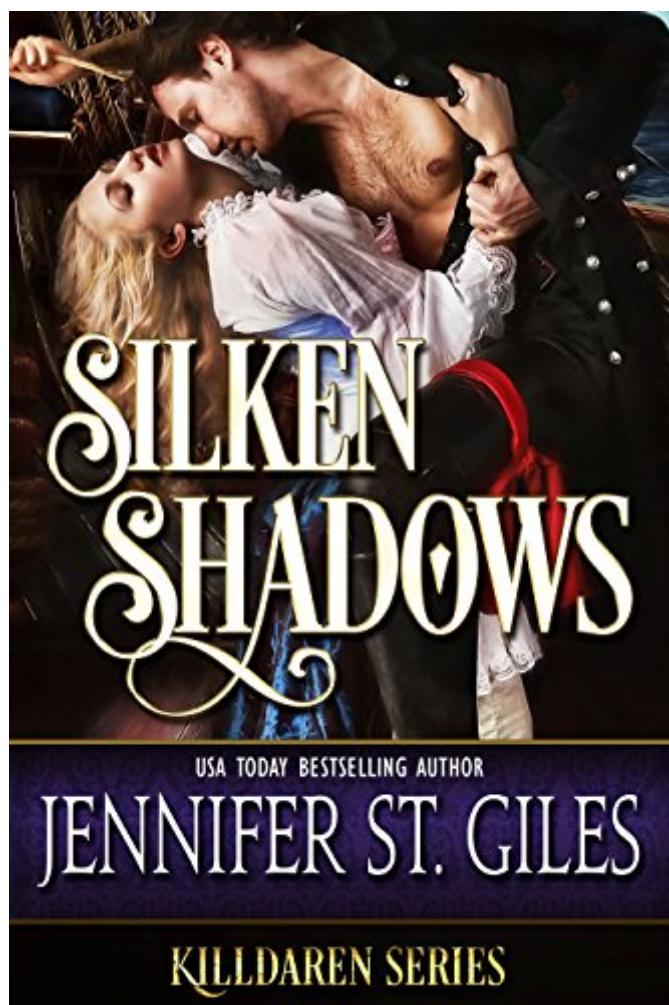


The book was found

Things I did not like about this series: All three of these novels are poorly edited to the point it was really annoying. I do not understand why a successful, well-known author would not have her books professionally edited. The language and actions are not true to the time period. They all three have

a lot of filler material and this third novel, was very repetitive with events from the first two books and it also contained repetitive thoughts of the heroine. I read book 1 and in spite of the previously mentioned deficits, I liked the plot and characters - particularly Cassie, Sean, and Bridget. It was my favorite. Book one is more believable in regards to paranormal happenings. Books 2 and 3 are quite far fetched and I personally didn't care for them as much. So why did I read book three? You could read each book independently and by the conclusions, each sister got her HEA. However, unless you read all three books you will not have all the answers to who killed whom and how, when and where the villain (villains) were apprehended. I was disappointed that the sisters personalities were not better developed. Other than a name change, they could have been the same individual! The heroes of books one and two were twin brothers and I thought the author did a great job developing their personalities. In fact, from her descriptions, I found them both interesting, handsome and sexy. Not so with the Captain of book three. He just didn't do it for me - seemed a rather weak man that I was not drawn to like the others. I also did not care for Gemini, the sister of book three. She was just too unbelievable with her paranormal skills, her "worldly" knowledge and independence but only being 19. My advise - Read book one and if you enjoyed it, read book 2. Skip book three in this series!

For a best selling author with more than 15 published novels, I would truly expect better. I noted the same types of errors in the previous two novels of this series. While not enough to completely ruin the story, the errors are numerous enough to distract the reader.
