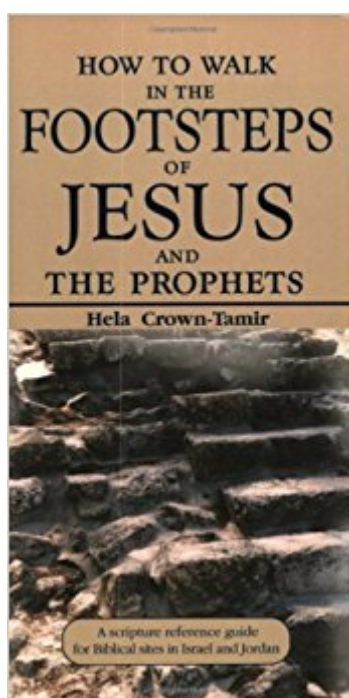

I currently use this volume in the study of the Word of God, not as a boots-on-the-ground guidebook. It provides valuable and succinct information and an eye witness approach towards the geographical sites of many Biblical events. I have the Kindle edition and consider it to be well thought out overall and the graphics display quite well in almost all instances. I would not consider the Kindle edition to be quite as "handy" as a hard-copy would be but it is usable and I have depended upon it along with my Biblical atlases and charts for the teaching of others about Bible events, Jesus Christ and our walk in the Body of Christ today. One day my wife and I will travel to Israel and will expect that this volume will be of great assistance at that time.
