

Read this book. Reading it and then looking at the past (and present actions) of Putin and you will see how it is all very, and often scarily, accurate.

Deep and analytical insight in Putin's psyche and background. Many facts unknown or long forgotten. The book is a bit too academic and too dry for its subject. Very often it is hard to catch authors intentions. Sometimes it looks like they strive to be impartial, next page they speak as they were Putin himself, next they criticize him, but rather cautiously. For me the main thing about Putin is that he is the Man of the Past. The book confirms my view, but without any attempt of moral judgment. I think it would be quite appropriate in this case

By the end of each chapter I became increasingly empathetic to Russia's desire to once again become a beacon for self sustainability in a global and interconnected economy. I challenge you to read all 14 chapters and still be of the opinion that Mr. Putin should be considered less than a Comrad, and that there is no path for which a shared strategic plan for peace cannot be developed and implemented between our two nations. Bottom line, he's a man seeking to lead his country the only way his country can be lead, and if we were to have scrutinized many of our greatest leaders with the veracity that we scrutinize Mr. Putin we would in fact have no faith in the history of our great nation.
