

## Synopsis

In many ways, this made his character a bit flat for me. I'd much rather seen how he overcome his inner trials - his anger at his enemies or situations, his frustration with being lame, etc. Instead he seems to just take it all in stride and it doesn't bother him.~The way David insists on calling Sett "Jonathan". For \*me\*, it just made David seem a little insane, and just didn't sit well with me. But despite those relatively minor cons, there were a lot of pros to this book. This was a well written, interesting book. I enjoyed travelling with Sett throughout his life, encountering people I knew from the Bible, and others I met for the first time. This book has definitely made me want to research more into Methibosheth's life, if it's possible.
