

Helen Gilhooly has lived and worked in Japan, and has a PGCE and an MA in Japanese. She is a university teacher trainer, language materials writer and senior director at a specialist language college in the UK. Dr Niamh Kelly is a lecturer in the Japanese Department at Dublin City University, Ireland. Michel Thomas (1914-2005) had an amazing life. Born in Poland, he spent his early years in France and then in France, where he studied psychology at the Sorbonne in Paris. When war broke out, he fought with the Resistance and suffered imprisonment in labour camps. At the end of the war he joined the US liberation army and later settled in the US where he established his world-famous language school. For more than 50 years he taught languages to the rich and famous and was the world's most sought-after language teacher. After creating several courses of his own, he passed on his method so that other teachers might use it too.

This product does precisely what it aims to do - teach someone with no experience in another language how to get off to a good start. The method is effective - a British instructor paired with a local national to guide in pronunciation, teaching a "class" consisting of a kid too smart for his own good and a woman who just can't seem to get it right. You, the listener, are intended to fall somewhere right in the middle. As a service member stationed in Japan the Michel Thomas method has enabled me to communicate with anyone from local store owners, to citizens, and manage to get around. The more I listen the more I learn, and therefore the more I am able communicate!

This review is not about the Michel Thomas method, which is far and above the best self-taught language learning method I have encountered so far. I have used the Michel Thomas CDs to learn a number of languages, and while the quality of instruction on this is excellent, I must say the Japanese course gets you much less farther than the French and Spanish courses. While this is no doubt in part due to the fact that it is a language with hardly any overlap whatsoever with English (unlike French and Spanish, where the number of cognates is much higher), the fact still remains that at the end of the entire Total course, you have learned no more than a dozen verbs (if that). Contrast this to Spanish or French, where you are using verbs like 'confirm', 'accept' and 'find' confidently midway through the course. I would recommend buyers and potential buyers of this course, who are expecting the same rate of progress as the more famous courses, to go in with moderated expectations. While Helen Gilhooly's teaching is first-rate, it moves a lot slower than the other languages that Michel Thomas personally taught.

I love and highly recommend this learning style. It's the best way to learn a language. It is much more natural and comprehensive than those regular audio "repeat after me" sets that rely on rote memorization.
