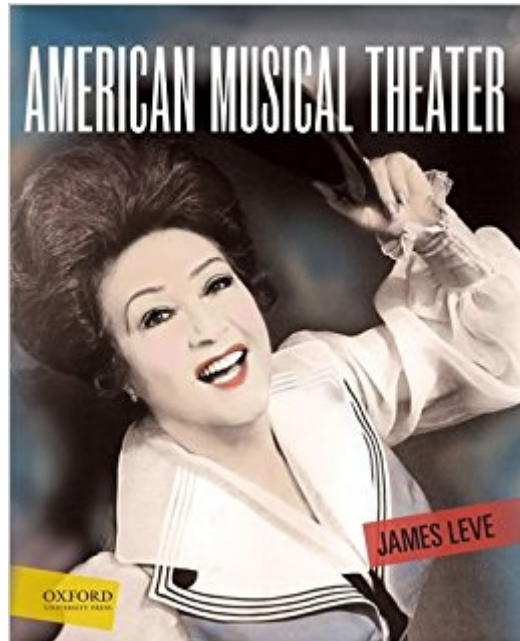




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American Musical Theater provides a chronological history of musical theater within a cultural context.
