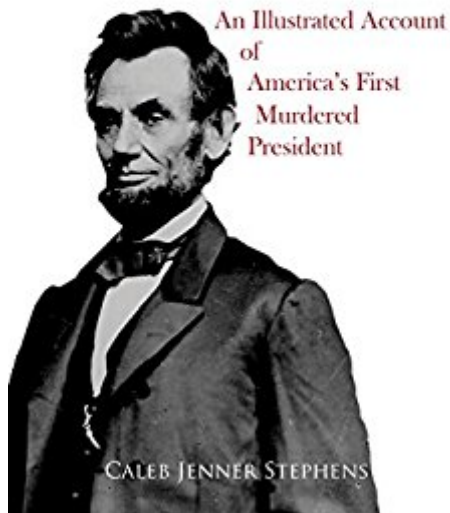




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The Assassination Of Abraham Lincoln: An Illustrated Account Of America's First Murdered President
