

Now in the Little Golden Book format, Disney's "The Little Mermaid tells the story of Ariel, a young mermaid who gets the chance to be human after making a deal with an evil sea witch.

Good little book

This review is to give you an idea of the look and feel of the book. Given the price (\$4 when I purchased), I know it is not a high-cost item, but I hope this helps. Content of the book is fine, but the quality is low. The size and quality are not the same as traditional Little Golden books. Not to be harsh, but I would place the quality of this book above something you'd get in a fast-food meal for free, but below what you'd expect from a traditional kids book in the \$10 range. It's more like

something you'd get a dollar store - the cover is thin, and the pages are bound in a way that they don't 'flip' naturally. As another reviewer pointed out, the pages protrude from under the cover, which is about as thick as shoe-box cardboard. In short, I wouldn't give this as a gift, but if you need a quick fix for a passing fad - it is worth the price they are asking. On a positive note, this book is Printed in the USA.

2017 Update: Probably not many people have the chance to do what I did... be expecting at the same time as your mother! That was one of the great things about being the oldest of 10 children, and it was terrific to be navigating motherhood for the first time with my own mom. My baby sister and my oldest son are just 3 months apart, and it's been an amazing experience for my mother and I to raise our kids together - including taking them, when they were 5 years old, to see the 1989 Disney movie this Little Golden Book was based on. I can remember my son protesting that this was "a girl's movie", but he ended up really enjoying it, and this book did a really nice job of hitting on all of the main aspects of the film along with all of the great characters - Ariel the mermaid princess and her BFF (best FISH friend!) Flounder, her father King Triton and his advisor Sebastian the crab, Scuttle the seagull, Prince Eric and his steward Sir Grimsby, along with Ursula the sea witch and her eel servants Flotsam and Jetsam. I'll give you the text of the book, so you can judge for yourself if you think your youngster will enjoy it: "King Triton, the great sea king, had many daughters who loved the undersea world. But Triton's youngest daughter, Ariel, dreamed of the world above the water's surface - the world of humans. Ariel and her friend Flounder liked to go to the surface to visit Scuttle the seagull. Scuttle told them all about the humans' objects that Ariel found at the bottom of the sea. One day Triton learned about Ariel's trips to the surface. The sea king grew very angry. Please come back!' cried Sebastian as he and Flounder swam after her. When Ariel surfaced, she saw a huge ship filled with sailors. When Ariel went in search of the prince, she was helped ashore by her friends. She tried to speak to them, but no sound came out. A short while later, Ariel saw Prince Eric. The prince had been lovesick ever since hearing her sing. At first the prince thought Ariel was the girl who had rescued him. But when he learned that she couldn't speak, he knew he was wrong. Prince Eric felt sorry for Ariel. She needed a place to stay, so he took her back to his palace. Over the next two days, Prince Eric grew to like Ariel more and more. During a romantic boat ride, Eric was about to kiss Ariel when Flotsam and Jetsam overturned the boat. 'That was a close one. Too close,' said Ursula, who was watching in her crystal ball. 'It's time Ursula took matters into her own tentacles.' The sea witch mixed a magic potion and changed herself into a beautiful young maiden. On the morning of the third day, there was a great excitement throughout the kingdom. Prince Eric was going to marry a young maiden he had just met! Ursula, disguised as the maiden, had used Ariel's voice to trick Eric. He

now believed that the maiden was the girl who had saved him from the shipwreck. Poor Ariel was heartbroken. The wedding ceremony was to take place on Prince Eric's new boat. Scuttle flew by just as the bride passed in front of a mirror. Her reflection was that of the sea witch! Scuttle rushed off to tell Ariel and the rest of his friends. Sebastian quickly formed a plan. Flounder helped Ariel get out to Eric's ship. Scuttle arranged for some of his seagull friends to delay the wedding. And Sebastian hurried to find King Triton. Prince Eric and the maiden were about to be married when a flock of seagulls, led by Scuttle, swooped down on the bride. She screamed in the sea witch's voice. Scuttle knocked the seashell containing Ariel's voice from around the maiden's neck. The shell shattered, and Ariel's voice returned to her. 'It was you all the time!' said Prince Eric. 'Oh, Eric, I wanted to tell you,' said Ariel. The sun disappeared over the horizon just as they were about to kiss. Ariel's three days were up. She changed back into a mermaid.
