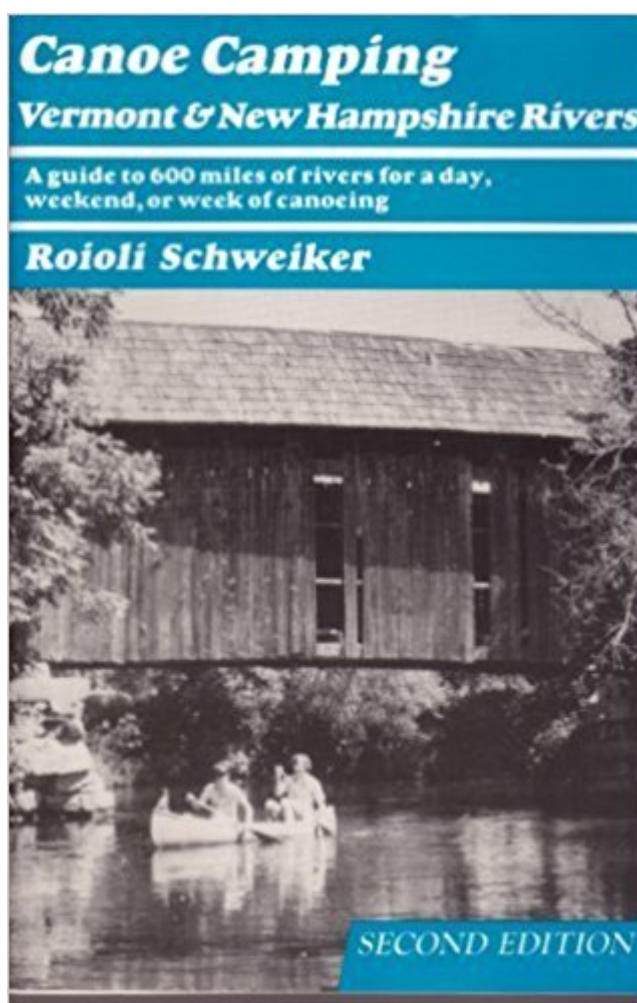

This book is very detailed in the description and directions to rivers it highlights, but it is limited in

the number of rivers in the two states.

This book's title is misleading, and provides next to no info about camping. Its information about water conditions and white water classifications is pathetic (and unsafe) as well. More information is available about the rivers the author chose to include in the DeLorme Vermont Gazetteer and Atlas. I wish I didn't order this book, it will become camping toilet paper or an emergency fire starter.
