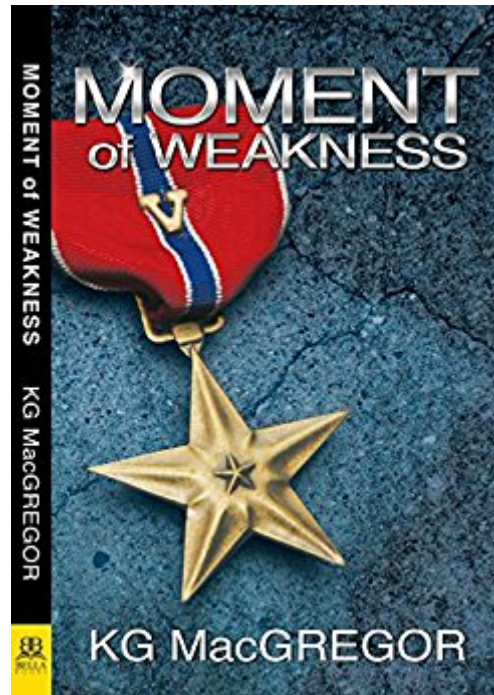

KG MacGregor handles an impossibly difficult subject with the grace and dignity I've come to trust her to provide. More than anything else, that's what struck me as I was reading this novel. Authors really do have their own unique voice. What is unique about KG is the way she cares for the reader's heart no matter the subject of the novel. It is not easy to successfully pull off a story where a relationship is in trouble. Readers can be brutally harsh to romance authors. But what we've come to understand with KG is that she will care for us along the journey. She will let us explore these themes with a sense of safety around us. That is a true gift. And it made this novel truly inspiring to read.

KG MacGregor is the award winning author of 24 books. *Moment of Weakness* gives readers a great story with two very strong and well developed characters. Marine Captain Suzann Redeker has earned a bronze star for valor for her service in Afghanistan. She has returned home to the small town of Colfax, Vermont. Now one of the small town's heroes, she has been asked to be the grand marshal of the town's Fourth of July parade. Marleigh Anderhal writes for the town's local newspaper. She is assigned to interview Suzann, or "Zann" as she is known, for the newspaper. The two women hit it off, date, and eventually marry. As the book begins, Zann and Marleigh are going through a rough time. Zann has lost her job, they are behind in payments for their home, and communication between the two of them has become challenging. There is a great deal that happens in this novel. Readers learn more about Zann's time in the service, Zann works out an intervention when Marleigh's best friend is being beaten by her boyfriend, and much, much more! MacGregor writes a tight, page turner of a novel that had me gripped right to the very last page, and rooting for Zann and Marleigh all along the way!

I've followed KG since the Xena Warrior Princess fanfic days. I love her fanfic and I love her books. I'm not going to write a synopsis on the book, like a book report because you can just buy the book and read it already. What I will say is that after a few books under her belt, KG continues to write good quality, interesting, fast paced books. Moment of Weakness keeps you turning the pages until you hit that last page. Then you sadly put the book down and wish there was more. I loved how she set up the flow of the book from present day to past then back and forth through the book. She gives us just enough information to keep the reader wanting to find out more. I enjoyed the military camaraderie and banter in the book. My father was retired military (Served in Korea in the army, then switched to the Air Force) and I especially liked the combat backstories/flashbacks. It reminded me some of the stories my father would tell. Suzann and Marleigh are interesting, they have their faults, they have their fights, and then . . . well, you will just have to read for yourself. I think the thing I like the most about KG's writing is that I always wonder what her characters are doing now. She makes them so real, you believe that they really are out there in the world doing their thing. Ok, enough already - go buy the book. Read it. Love it. Be annoyed that it's finished. Want more. It's what us readers do.

I loved Moment of Weakness. What an extraordinary story. I think civilians who have never been in combat can't begin to understand what veterans live with every day. Beautifully written with love and compassion. A powerful salute to women veterans.
