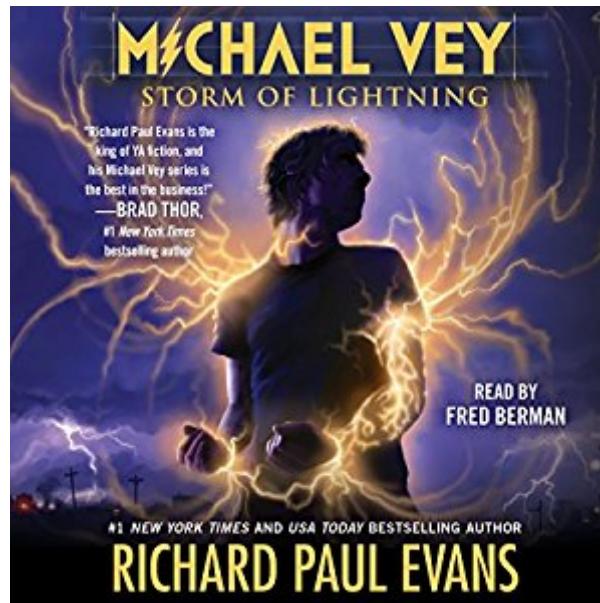




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# Storm Of Lightning: Michael Vey, Book 5

The book builds suspense and connects you to the series. The characters gain traction with the plot. There is not enough action. There is not a climax, but a couple of satisfying surprises. The story and intrigue kept me reading. The story is too short. The relationship with Taylor is cute but the bed time is not necessary, especially for hormonal youth readers. Less romance and MORE FIGHTING!!

A great continuation of the Michael Vey saga. The plot development and suspense level are certainly on par with the first four installments. To the reviewer who suggested that there was not much action I would reply that there was enough, and it was a relief that the Electroclan survived a whole book without being very nearly killed or tortured. The reason my rating is only four stars is that I am not wild about "cliffhanger" endings. I would strongly recommend this book to anyone who has read the first four books. As a novel it does not stand alone, as it is right in the middle of an epic tale.

Nothing incredibly exciting happened with the Electroclan (there were a few moments of tension and excitement, but it was mostly them traveling and recovering from rescuing Jade Dragon in the last book). The real story development comes from Hatch, his kids, and the Elgen in general. A lot happened in their story that will keep readers on the edge of their seat. Overall, while this book is called "Storm of Lightning", it is actually the the calm before the storm. Looking forward to the next book!
